The Tribal Information Sharing and Analysis Center (Tribal-ISAC), a division of not-for-profit Tribal Share, Inc., is a platform for cyber threat information sharing, threat prevention, protection, community response, and a managed and trusted collaboration with other government agencies for the nation's tribal governments and their operations and enterprises.

It is a resource, created by tribes for tribes, that not only promotes the improvement of their cybersecurity posture but also their sovereignty through confidential information sharing with a community of trusted peers.

The Tribal-ISAC, a 501(c)(3), provides a safe and secure environment for the nation's federally recognized sovereign Native American tribal governments, all of their operations and enterprises, including Alaska Native communities, villages and organizations ("Tribe(s)"), to share and mitigate security threat information, to share best practices, and is the conduit for security information sharing among Tribes.
